FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Champlin Petroleum Company, seeks an order creating a new oil pool for the Mancos formation, with special pool rules including a provision for 160-acre spacing, Sandoval County, New Mexico.
- (3) That in companion Case No. 8030, Samuel Gary Oil Producers, Inc. seeks an order creating a new oil pool for the Mancos formation, with special pool rules including a provision for 320-acre spacing, Sandoval County, New Mexico.
- (4) That Cases 8063 and 8030 were consolidated for the purpose of obtaining testimony.
- (5) That the Commission, by Order No. R-7471, did grant the application of Samuel Gary Oil Producers, Inc. in Case 8030.
