FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Tubb formation, advertised as the Tubb Oil Pool, should be dismissed pending further study.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(d) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Tubb formation, advertised as the Tubb Oil Pool to consist of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 10: SE/4 SW/4

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be and the same is hereby $\underline{\text{dismissed}}$.
