ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on August 15, 1956, at 9 o'clock a.m. September 13, 1956, 9 o'clock a.m. October 17, 1956, and at 9 o'clock a.m. January 16, 1957, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 30<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1957, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Tubb formation, advertised as the Tubb Oil Pool, should be dismissed pending further study.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(d) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Tubb formation, advertised as the Tubb Oil Pool to consist of the following described area:
