## BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 25, 1950 on the motion of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and upon the recommendation of the Southeastern New Mexico Nomenclature Committee.

The Commission having heard the evidence presented

FINDS:

1. It has jurisdiction of this case and the parties interested therein, due notice having been given.

2. The several areas hereinafter described each comprise a separate common reservoir of oil in the producing horizon designated and are each oil pools as follows:
