IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECONSIDERING:

ITS ORDER NO. 779, ENTERED ON JULY 27, 1948, IN CASE NO. 149 ESTABLISHING AN 80-ACRE SPACING PATTERN AND PRORATION UNIT FOR THE CROSSROADS DEVONIAN POOL BELOW 12,200 FEET, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on for hearing at 10:00 e'clock A.M. on the 21st day of November, 1950, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 29th day of December, 1950, the Commission having duly considered the testimony presented and the record in the case

FINDS:

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1. That due public notice of the November 21, 1950 hearing was duly had, and the Commission having by Order No. 799 retained jurisdiction of the case, has full authority to hear and determine the matter.

2. That the motion of Magnolia Petroleum Company for dismissal is not well taken.

3. That the testimony adduced at said hearing related only te Mid-Continent wells in the Crossreads peel, and the Commission is not able to determine from such testimony whether or not 80-acre spacing and proration units over the peel as a whele has, is or will prevent waste, preclude inequities, and/or preserve correlative rights in the said Crossreads peel.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the motion for dismissal is hereby denied.

2. That the case be and the same hereby is continued to March 20, 1951, at which hearing all available pertinent information from all producing wells in said Crossroads peel shall be presented to the Commission.

3. That pending final determination of the matter, based upon full information, duly presented, Order No. 779 heretofore entered authorizing the Crossroads 80-acre spacing and proration units, shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That proper notice shall be given to all producers and others interested in the Corssroads pool of the March 20, 1951 hearing.
