ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10 a. m. on November 20, 1951, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of December, 1951, the Commission, having considered the testimony adduced and exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS: (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That during the course of drilling it was discovered that the Benson-Montin well No. 6 was improperly located, due to inadvertence, or a surveyor's error.

(3) That the entire area surrounding the Benson-Montin Well No. 6 has been unitized and correlative rights of adjoining lessees will not be impaired or infringed, and

There appearing no objection thereto,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That the location of Benson & Montin's Benson-Montin Well No. 6, 1340 feet north of the south line and 1110 feet east of the west line of Section 22, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby is approved.
