THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, ABOLISHING, CONTRACTING VERTICAL LIMITS, AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN EDDY, LEA, AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 11, 1964, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 18th day of June, 1964, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation of Bough-San Andres Gas Pool. Said Bough-San Andres Gas Pool was discovered by Pan American Petroleum Corporation, Federal "A" No. 1, located in Unit N of Section 13, Township 9 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. It was completed in San Andres on January 18, 1964. The top of perforations is 4746 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Queen formation, said pool to bear the designation of Lovington-Queen Gas Pool. Said Lovington-Queen Gas Pool was discovered by Sunray DX Oil Company, New Mexico State AL No. 1, located in Unit I of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed in Queen on August 13, 1963. The top of perforations is 4300 feet.
- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Middle Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation of North Bagley-Middle Pennsylvanian Pool. Said North Bagley-Middle Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Texas Pacific Oil Company, J. P. Collier No. 1, located in Unit F of Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in Middle Pennsylvanian on May 16, 1964. The top of perforations is 9862 feet. The special vertical limits are top of pool at -5397 feet subsea and bottom of pool at

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-5727 feet subsea. Type Log: Texas Pacific Oil Company, J. P. Collier No. 1, Unit F, Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM.

- (5) That there is need for the contraction of the vertical limits of the North Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, originally defined as top of pool at -4783 feet subsea and bottom of pool at -5727 feet subsea. The new special vertical limits are defined as top of pool at -4783 feet subsea and bottom of pool at -5397 feet subsea. Type Log: Texas Pacific Oil Company, J. P. Collier No. 1, Unit F, Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM.
- (6) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Atoka formation, said pool to bear the designation of South Prairie-Atoka Gas Pool. Said South Prairie-Atoka Gas Pool was discovered by Lone Star Producing Company, Federal New Mexico "B" No. 1, located in Unit M of Section 21, Township 8 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed in Atoka on February 10, 1964. The top of perforations is 12,057 feet.
- (7) That there is need for the contraction of the vertical limits of the South Prairie-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, to include only the Cisco zone of the Pennsylvanian formation and to redesignate the South Prairie-Pennsylvanian Pool to the South Prairie-Cisco Pool.
- (8) That there is need for the consolidation of the Indian Hills-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, inasmuch as the pools produce from the same formation. Said consolidation to be accomplished by the abolishment of the Indian Hills-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and extension of the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool.
- (9) That there is need for certain extensions to the North Benson Queen-Grayburg Pool, the Maljamar Pool, the East Millman Queen-Grayburg Pool, and the Indian Basin-Morrow Gas Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico, the Flying "M"-San Andres Pool, the Justis-Blinebry Pool, the Mescalero-San Andres Pool, the Pearl-Queen Pool, the Vacuum-Abo Reef Pool, and the Weir-Blinebry Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and the Lusk-Strawn Pool in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for San Andres production, is hereby created and designated as the Bough-San Andres Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM SECTION 13: SW/4

(b) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Queen production, is hereby created and designated as the Lovington-Queen Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM SECTION 14: SE/4

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(c) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Middle Pennsylvanian production, is hereby created and designated as the North Bagley-Middle Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM SECTION 10: W/2

Special vertical limits, top pool at -5397 feet subsea, bottom pool at -5727 feet subsea. Type Log: Texas Pacific Oil Company, J. P. Collier Well No. 1, located in Unit F of Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM.

- (d) Contract the vertical limits of the North Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, to be from -4783 feet subsea at the top of the pool to -5397 feet subsea at the bottom of the pool. Type Log: Texas Pacific Oil Company, J. P. Collier No. 1, Unit F, Section 10, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM.
- (e) That a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Atoka production, is hereby created and designated as the South Prairie-Atoka Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM SECTION 21: SW/4

- (f) Contract the vertical limits of the South Prairie-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, to include only the Cisco zone of the Pennsylvanian formation and redesignate the South Prairie-Pennsylvanian Pool the South Prairie-Cisco Pool.
- (g) That the North Benson Queen-Grayburg Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM SECTION 27: NW/4

(h) That the Flying "M"-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM SECTION 16: E/2 and SW/4 SECTION 21: NE/4

(i) That the Justis-Blinebry Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as here-tofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM SECTION 3: E/2 NE/4

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(j) That the Lusk-Strawn Pool in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM SECTION 27: W/2

(m) That the East Millman Queen-Grayburg Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:
