Please explain reason for why this event was beyond this operator's control	Gas was routed to flare when the facility received a surge of inlet liquids. The facility is sized properly for the amount of gas/liquid received based on volume, gas composition and temperature. This inlet pipeline is pigged routinely to maintain pipeline integrity. When an upstream producer has an equipment malfunction, emergency, or abnormal conditions, it can cause carryover of liquid from the producer into the gas delivery to this facility which can cause the amount of liquid into the facility to vary. This type of event from producers is sudden, and unforeseen, and is out of the control of the operator.
Steps taken to limit the duration and magnitude of vent or flare	Gas was flared until the excess liquids were processed.
Corrective actions taken to eliminate the cause and reoccurrence of vent or flare	The excess liquids were processed, and the emission event ended.
