To Whom It May Concern:

Ensolum, LLC (Ensolum), on behalf of Oxy USA Inc. (Oxy), has prepared the following *Reclamation Report* for the Sundance SDS 11-1 SWD (Site). This *Reclamation Report* documents the Site history, reclamation activities completed to date, and proposes a vegetation monitoring plan.

BACKGROUND

The Site is located in Unit K, Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 31 East, in Eddy County, New Mexico (32.228333°, -103.731944°) and is associated with oil and gas exploration and production operations on Federal Land managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM).

On August 30, 2022, a 4-inch polyline failure resulted in the release of approximately 50 barrels (bbls) of produced water onto the caliche lease road and into the pasture. No free-standing fluids were recovered. Oxy reported the release to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) on a Notification of Release (NOR) on August 31, 2022. The release was assigned Incident Number nAPP2224356841.

Delineation and excavation of impacted soil was completed at the Site between September 2022 and October 2023. The excavated portion of the release measured approximately 5,400 square feet. A total of approximately 100 cubic yards of impacted soil were removed during the excavation activities. Based on the delineation and excavation soil sample analytical results, a *Revised Closure Report* was submitted to the NMOCD on December 13, 2023. The NMOCD approved the *Revised Closure Report* on January 30, 2024. Additional details regarding the release, Site Characterization, delineation and excavation activities, and soil sample analytical results can be referenced in the approved *Revised Closure Report* included as an attachment in this report. Remediation of the release was completed in accordance with Title 19, Chapter 15, Part 29, Section 12 (19.15.29.12) of the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC).

RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES

Upon completion of excavation activities and receipt of final laboratory analytical results, the excavation areas were backfilled with locally procured topsoil and caliche and the disturbed area was graded and

contoured to match the surrounding topography. The excavation area on the lease road was backfilled with caliche and the excavation in the pasture was backfilled with locally procured topsoil, consistent with the surrounding native soil type. The release extent and reclamation area are shown on the attached Figure 1. Photographic documentation is included as Appendix A.

One representative 5-point composite sample (PS01) was collected from the backfill material on August 18, 2025. The backfill soil sample was transported under strict chain-of-custody procedures to Cardinal Laboratories in Hobbs, New Mexico, for analysis of the following constituents of concern (COCs): total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH)—gasoline range organics (GRO), TPH-diesel range organics (DRO), and TPH-oil range organics (ORO) following EPA Method 8015M/D; and chloride following Standard Method 4500.

Laboratory analytical results for the backfill soil sample confirmed compliance with NMOCD requirements for the reclaimed area to contain non-waste containing, uncontaminated, earthen material with chloride concentrations less than 600 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) and TPH concentrations less than 100 mg/kg. The laboratory analytical results are summarized in the attached Table 1 and the complete laboratory analytical report is included as Appendix B.

The lease road remains in-use. No further reclamation activities for the lease road are warranted at this time. The reclaimed pasture area was seeded on July 3, 2025, with the below BLM seed mixture #1 for loamy sites. The seed was applied with a broadcast seed spreader at double the rate specified in pounds of pure live seed (PLS) per acre to account for the application method.

Following broadcast seeding, in the area was chained to cover the seed. Photographs of the backfilled excavation and seeding of the reclaimed area are provided in Appendix A.

VEGETATION MONITORING

The reclaimed pasture area will be monitored for vegetation growth to ensure that reclamation activities were successful. Focus for this phase will be to prevent erosion and Site degradation, and to monitor for and treat invasive and noxious weed species.

- Annual inspections will take place at the location to assess revegetation progress until vegetation is consistent with local natural vegetation density.
- If necessary, an additional application of the BLM seed mix will be applied.
- Noxious and invasive weeds will be identified and treated by licensed contracted herbicide applicator or mechanically removed.

A *Revegetation Report* will be submitted to the NMOCD and BLM once vegetation growth in the reclaimed pasture area has uniform vegetative cover that reflects a life-form ratio of plus or minus 50 percent (%) of pre-disturbance levels and a total percent plant cover of at least 70% of pre-disturbance levels, excluding noxious weeds, per NMAC 19.15.29.13 D.(3).







1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Executive Summary

- On August 30, 2022, a release of produced water was reported from a 4" poly line failure at the Sundance SDS 11-1 SWD, hereinafter referred to as the "Site". Approximately 50 barrels (bbls) of produced water were released onto the caliche road and impacted an area approximately 560 feet long by 20 to 70 feet wide. The line was repaired, and Oxy USA Inc. (Oxy) contracted Ensolum, LLC (Ensolum) to perform sampling of the approximate spill location at the Site.
- On September 27, 2022, in order to initially assess the nature and extent of the release, Ensolum arrived on-Site and collected a total of 4 composite soil samples (FS-1 through FS-4) from locations within the impacted area. In addition, Ensolum collected 4 soil samples (North, East, South and West) in each direction outside of the impacted area in order to delineate the potentially impacted soils. The composite soil samples were collected from depths ranging from 0-2 feet below ground surface (bgs).
- Due to the unknown depth to groundwater in the 0.5-mile vicinity, a depth to water soil boring (SB-1 (C-04687-POD1)) was installed on November 29, 2022 by Ensolum personnel. The soil boring was installed adjacent to the release area. The soil boring was installed to 112.53 feet bgs, and groundwater was not encountered 72-hours after the soil boring was installed. The applicable Closure Criteria were utilized based on the lack of groundwater observed within the first 112.53 feet bgs at the Site.
- On December 28, 2022, Ensolum returned to the Site and collected a total of 18 composite soil samples (FS-5 through FS-22) from locations within the impacted area. The composite soil samples were collected at a depth of 0-0.25 feet bgs.
- The primary objective of the closure activities was to reduce chemical of concern (COC) concentrations in the on-Site soils to below the applicable New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department (ENMNRD) Oil Conservation Division (OCD) Closure Criteria for Soils Impacted by a Release using the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC) 19.15.29 Releases as guidance.
- On January 24, 2023 a Closure Report was submitted to the New Mexico ENMNRD OCD for approval.
- On February 13, 2023 the New Mexico ENMNRD OCD rejected the Closure Report. Steps were subsequently taken by Oxy to address the requirements needed for closure.

- Based on the request from the New Mexico EMRD OCD, composite samples FS-8 through FS-22 were collected on September 14, 2023, from depths ranging from 0.25-0.50 feet bgs.
- Based on analytical results, Ensolum returned to the Site on October 11, 2023 to collect composite sample FS-9 from a depth interval of 0.50-0.75 feet bgs.
- The final excavation areas reached a maximum depth of 2 feet bgs.
- Based on the laboratory analytical results, the final composite soil samples did not exhibit benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylene (BTEX), total BTEX, total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH), gasoline range organics (GRO), diesel range organics (DRO), motor oil range organics (MRO) or chloride concentrations above the applicable NMOCDD Closure Criteria.

Based on field observations and laboratory analytical results, no additional investigation or corrective action appears warranted at this time.

1.3 Project Objective

The primary objective of the closure activities was to reduce COC concentrations in the on-Site soils to below the applicable New Mexico EMNRD OCD closure criteria concentrations.

2.0 CLOSURE CRITERIA

The Site is subject to regulatory oversight by the New Mexico EMNRD OCD. In order to address activities related to exempt oil and gas releases, the New Mexico EMNRD OCD references NMAC 19.15.29 *Releases*, which establishes investigation and abatement action requirements for sites subject to reporting and/or corrective action. Ensolum utilized information provided by Oxy, the general site characteristics, and information available from the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer (OSE) and the New Mexico EMNRD OCD Imaging database to determine the appropriate closure criteria for the Site.

- The Site is not located within 300 feet of a New Mexico ENMRD OCD-defined continuously flowing watercourse or any other significant watercourse.
- The Site is not located within 200 feet of a lakebed, sinkhole, or playa lake.
- The Site is not located within 300 feet from an occupied permanent residence, school, hospital, institution, or church.

- According to the OSE WRSS database there are no private, domestic freshwater wells used by less than five (5) households for domestic or stock water purposes identified within 500 feet of the Site.
- According to the OSE WRSS database there are no freshwater wells identified within 1,000 feet of the Site as declared in the previous bullet.
- The Site is not located within incorporated municipal boundaries or within a defined municipal fresh water well field covered under a municipal ordinance adopted pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 3-27-3.
- The Site is not located within 300 feet of a wetland.
- Based on information identified on the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division's GIS, Maps and Mine Data database, the Site is not located within an area overlying a subsurface mine.
- Based on the Karst Occurrence Potential (.kmz) provided by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), the Site is not located within an unstable area.
- The Site is noted to be located within an area of minimal flood hazard.

Based on the identified siting criteria, cleanup goals for soils remaining in place at the Site include:

3.0 SOIL REMEDIATION ACTIVITIES

On August 30, 2022, a release of produced water was reported from a 4" poly line failure at the Sundance SDS 11-1 SWD. Approximately 50 bbls of produced water were released onto the caliche road and impacted an area approximately 560 feet long by 20 to 70 feet wide. The line was repaired, and Oxy contracted Ensolum to perform sampling of the approximate spill location at the Site.

On September 27, 2022, in order to initially assess the nature and extent of the release, Ensolum arrived on-Site and collected a total of 4 composite soil samples (FS-1 through FS-4) from locations within the impacted area. In addition, Ensolum collected 4 soil samples (North, East, South and West) in each direction outside of the impacted area in order to delineate the potentially impacted soils. The composite soil samples were collected from depths ranging from 0-2 feet bgs.

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Due to the unknown depth to groundwater in the 0.5-mile vicinity, a depth to water soil boring (SB-1 (C-04687-POD1)) was installed on November 29, 2022 by Ensolum personnel. The soil boring was installed adjacent to the release area. The soil boring was installed to 112.53 feet bgs, and groundwater was not encountered 72-hours after the soil boring was installed. The applicable Closure Criteria were utilized based on the lack of groundwater observed within the first 112.53 feet bgs at the Site.

On December 28, 2022, Ensolum returned to the Site and collected a total of 18 composite soil samples (FS-5 through FS-22) from locations within the impacted area. The composite soil samples were collected at a depth of 0-0.25 feet bgs.

On September 14, 2023, composite samples FS-8 through FS-22 were collected from depths ranging from 0.25-0.50 feet bgs, after excavation activities.

Based on analytical results, Ensolum returned to the site on October 11, 2023 to collect composite sample FS-9 from a depth interval of 0.50-0.75 feet bgs.

Figure 3 identifies approximate pothole soil sample locations and approximate dimensions of the impacted area with respect to the Site (**Appendix A**). Photographic documentation of the field activities is included in **Appendix C**.

4.0 SOIL SAMPLING PROGRAM

Ensolum's composite soil sampling program included the collection of 38 composite soil samples from 22 locations within the impacted area (FS-1 through FS-22), and 4 soil samples from 4 locations outside of the impacted area (North, East, South and West). The composite soil samples were collected from depths of 0-0.25 feet bgs, 0.25-0.50 feet bgs, 0.50-0.75 feet bgs or 1-2 feet bgs.

The composite soil samples were collected and placed in laboratory prepared glassware, labeled/sealed using laboratory supplied labels and custody seals, and stored on ice in a cooler. The samples were relinquished to Cardinal Laboratories in Hobbs, New Mexico for standard laboratory analysis.

5.0 SOIL LABORATORY ANALYTICAL METHODS

The composite soil samples were analyzed for BTEX utilizing Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) SW-846 Method 8021B, TPH GRO/DRO/MRO utilizing EPA SW-846 Method 8015M, and chloride utilizing EPA Method 4500-Cl B.

Laboratory analytical results are summarized in **Table 1** in **Appendix D**. The executed chain-of-custody forms and laboratory analytical reports are provided in **Appendix E**.

6.0 DATA EVALUATION

Ensolum compared the benzene, total BTEX, TPH GRO/DRO/MRO, and chloride concentrations associated with the final composite soil samples collected from the impacted area (FS-1 through FS-22) and delimitation samples outside the impacted area (North, East, South and West) to the applicable NMOCD Closure Criteria.

- Laboratory analytical results indicate benzene concentrations for the composite soil samples are below the laboratory sample detection limits (SDLs), which are below the applicable NMOCD Closure Criteria of 10 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg).
- Laboratory analytical results indicate that total BTEX concentrations for the composite soil samples below the laboratory SDLs, which are below the applicable NMOCD Closure Criteria of 50 mg/kg.

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- Laboratory analytical results indicate combined TPH GRO/DRO/MRO concentrations for the composite soil samples are below the laboratory SDLs and/or the applicable NMOCD Closure Criteria of 100 mg/kg for ≤ 50 feet.
- Laboratory analytical results indicate chloride concentrations for the composite soil samples are below the applicable NMOCD Closure Criteria of 600 mg/kg for ≤ 50 feet.

Laboratory analytical results are summarized in **Table 1** in **Appendix D**.

7.0 RECLAMATION AND RE-VEGETATION

Subsequent to the results of the composite soil sampling, it was determined that no further excavation or remediation was warranted at the Site. The spill area is a caliche road and requires no reclamation or re-vegetation.

8.0 FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

- On August 30, 2022, a release of produced water was reported from a 4" poly line failure at the Sundance SDS 11-1 SWD. Approximately 50 bbls of produced water were released onto the caliche road and impacted an area approximately 560 feet long by 20 to 70 feet wide. The line was repaired, and Oxy contracted Ensolum to perform sampling of the approximate spill location at the Site.
- On September 27, 2022, in order to initially assess the nature and extent of the release, Ensolum arrived on-Site and collected a total of 4 composite soil samples (FS-1 through FS-4) from locations within the impacted area. In addition, Ensolum collected 4 soil samples (North, East, South and West) in each direction outside of the impacted area in order to delineate the potentially impacted soils. The composite soil samples were collected from depths ranging from 0-2 feet bgs.
- Due to the unknown depth to groundwater in the 0.5-mile vicinity, a depth to water soil boring (SB-1 (C-04687-POD1)) was installed on November 29, 2022 by Ensolum personnel. The soil boring was installed adjacent to the release area. The soil boring was installed to 112.53 feet bgs, and groundwater was not encountered 72-hours after the soil boring was installed. The applicable Closure Criteria were utilized based on the lack of groundwater observed within the first 112.53 feet bgs at the Site.
- On December 28, 2022, Ensolum returned to the Site and collected a total of 18 composite soil samples (FS-5 through FS-22) from locations within the impacted area. The composite soil samples were collected at a depth of 0-0.25 feet bgs.
- Based on the high vehicle traffic on the lease road and laboratory analytical results, no additional excavation or remediation was required at that time.
- The primary objective of the closure activities was to reduce COC concentrations in the on-Site soils to below the applicable New Mexico EMNRD OCD Closure Criteria for Soils Impacted by a Release using the NMAC 19.15.29 *Releases* as guidance.
- On January 24, 2023 a Closure Report was submitted to the New Mexico ENMRD OCD for approval.
- On February 13, 2023 the New Mexico ENMRD OCD rejected the Closure Report. Steps were subsequently taken by Oxy to address the requirements needed for closure.

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- Based on the request from the New Mexico EMRD OCD, composite samples FS-8 through FS-22 were collected on September 14, 2023, from depths ranging from 0.25-0.50 feet bgs.
- Based on analytical results, Ensolum returned to the Site on October 11, 2023 to collect composite sample FS-9 from a depth interval of 0.50-0.75 feet bgs.
- The final excavation areas reached a maximum depth of 2 feet bgs.
- Based on the laboratory analytical results, the final composite soil samples collected from the impacted area did not exhibit benzene, total BTEX, TPH GRO/DRO, TPH GRO/DRO/MRO or chloride concentrations above the applicable NMOCD Closure Criteria.

Based on field observations and laboratory analytical results, no additional investigation or corrective action appears warranted at this time.




SITE VICINITY MAP





17-16 Construction of a water well by anyone without a valid New Mexico Well Driller License is illegal, and the landowner shall bear the cost of plugging the well by a licensed New Mexico well driller. This does not apply to driven wells, the casing of which does not exceed two and three-eighths inches outside diameter.

17-1A Depth of the well shall not exceed the thickness of the valley fill.

17-4 No water shall be appropriated and beneficially used under this permit.

17-6 The well authorized by this permit shall be plugged completely using the following method per Rules and Regulations Governing Well Driller Licensing, Construction, Repair and Plugging of Wells; Subsection C of 19.27.4.30 NMAC unless an alternative plugging method is proposed by the well owner and approved by the State Engineer upon completion of the permitted use. All pumping appurtenance shall be removed from the well prior to plugging. To plug a well, the entire well shall be filled from the bottom upwards to ground surface using a tremie pipe. The bottom of the tremie shall remain submerged in the sealant throughout the entire sealing process; other placement methods may be acceptable and approved by the state engineer. The well shall be plugged with an office of the state engineer approved sealant for use in the plugging of non-artesian wells. The well driller shall cut the casing off at least four (4) feet below ground surface and fill the open hole with at least two vertical feet of approved sealant. The driller must fill or cover any open annulus with sealant. Once the sealant has cured, the well driller or well owner may cover the seal with soil. A Plugging Report for said well shall be filed with the Office of the State Engineer in a District Office within 30 days of completion of the plugging.

Specific Plugging Conditions of Approval for Well located in Eddy County.

1. Water well drilling and well drilling activities, including well plugging, are regulated under 19.27.4 NMAC, which requires any person engaged in the business of well drilling within New Mexico to obtain a Well Driller License issued by the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer (NMOSE). Therefore, the firm of a New Mexico licensed Well Driller shall perform the well plugging.
2. The total Theoretical volume of sealant required for abandonment is approximately 100 gallons. Total minimum volume of necessary sealant shall be calculated upon sounding the actual pluggable depth of well, which is estimated at 110 feet.
3. A Type I/II Portland cement mixed with 5.2 to 6.0 gallons of fresh water per 94-lb sack of cement is approved for the plugging the well.
4. Sealant shall be placed by pumping through a tremie pipe extended to near well bottom and kept below top of the slurry column as the well is plugged from bottom-upwards in a manner that displaces the standing water column upwards from below. Tremie pipe may be pulled as necessary to retain minimal submergence in the advancing column of sealant.
5. Should cement "shrinks-back" occur in the well, use of a tremie for topping off is required for cement placement deeper than 20 feet below land surface or if water is present in the casing. The approved sealant for topping off is identified in condition 3. of these Specific Conditions of Approval.

6. Any open annulus encountered surrounding the casing shall also be sealed by the placement of the approved sealant. When plugging shallow wells with no construction or environmental concerns, and if the well record on a well to be plugged shows a proper 20-foot annular seal, a plugging plan can propose the use of clean fill material to a nominal 30 feet bgs, then placing an OSE approved sealant to surface. Lacking that information, we would require an excavation of at least 2-feet which shall then be filled in its entirety with sealant to surface.
7. Should the NMED, or another regulatory agency sharing jurisdiction of the project authorize, or by regulation require a more stringent well plugging procedure than herein acknowledged, the more-stringent procedure should be followed. This, in part, includes provisions regarding pre-authorization to proceed, contaminant remediation, inspection, pulling/perforating of casing, or prohibition of free discharge of any fluid from the borehole during or related to the plugging process.
