Please explain reason for why this event was beyond this operator's control	Due to DCP (Phillips 66) & Durango (Kinetik) purchasers both experiencing force majeure shut-in events simultaneously the facility's pressure relief safety measures were forced into their working constraints.
Steps taken to limit the duration and magnitude of vent or flare	The facilities pressure relief safety system functions only to maintain safe working parameters of the equipment. Once the force majeure event is rectified, these safety functions will no longer be in action as the facility returns to safe and normal operating conditions.
Corrective actions taken to eliminate the cause and reoccurrence of vent or flare	We have established two separate gas purchasing contracts to maximize the takeaway potential of this gas. Each purchaser can carry gas to market, and is not dependent on the other.
