Additional Instructions: At intersection of US Hwy 285 S and W Kincaid Ranch Rd (Co 38) travel W for approximately 2.9mi, stay left on W Kincaid Ranch Rd (Co 38) and travel S/SW for 3.2mi, arrive at gate at (32.689971, -104.481662) code: 0924, travel on west access road 1.01mi W, turn left onto location.

An OCD representative may be available onsite at the date and time reported. In the absence or presence of an OCD representative, sampling pursuant to 19.15.29.12.D NMAC is required. Sampling must be performed following an approved sampling plan or pursuant to 19.15.29.12.D.(1).(c) NMAC. Should there be a change in the scheduled date and time of the sampling event, then another notification should be resubmitted through OCD permitting as soon as possible.

- **Failure to notify the OCD of sampling events including any changes in date/time per the requirements of 19.15.29.12.D.(1).(a) NMAC, may result in the remediation closure samples not being accepted.**
- **If confirmation sampling is going to take place over multiple days, individual C-141N applications must be submitted for each sampling date. Date ranges are not currently accepted on the C-141N application.**
