Please see the following for answers to your questions.

1. Any emergency services notified?  
A: No, emergency services were not notified.
2. Was anyone injured?  
A: No, no one was injured.
3. What was the cause of the release?  
A: The release was caused by the internal corrosion of the flowline.
4. Was the release in a highly visible area to the public?  
A: No, the release was not in a highly visible area to the public.

5. Has the facility been cleared by safety personnel? If no, please explain the current conditions.

A: Yes, the facility has been cleared by safety personnel.

6. Was the release confined to the well pad? If no, please explain the current conditions.

A: No, the release occurred entirely off pad.

7. Were any key environmental receptors impacted by the release (riverine, karst, wetland, 100-year floodplain, etc.)?

A: Yes, a portion of the release encountered a watercourse. There is currently no water in the watercourse.

8. How was the source of the release stopped? (e.g. valve, auto shut off, fire distinguished, etc.)

A: The released was stopped by shutting in the line.

A: Only authorized personnel are permitted on site.

10. How was the release stabilized and contained?

A: Natural barriers contained the release.

A: The extent of the release area is not currently known. I will be traveling to location next week to gather data.

12. If currently known, what is the estimated depth of contamination?

A: The estimated depth of contamination is not currently known.

A: No other regulatory agencies are involved

14. How were the calculations of released and recovered materials determined?

A: Release volumes were estimated based on the dimensions of the release.

15. Did the release reach any watercourses?

A: Yes, the release reached a watercourse, however, there is currently not water in the watercourse.

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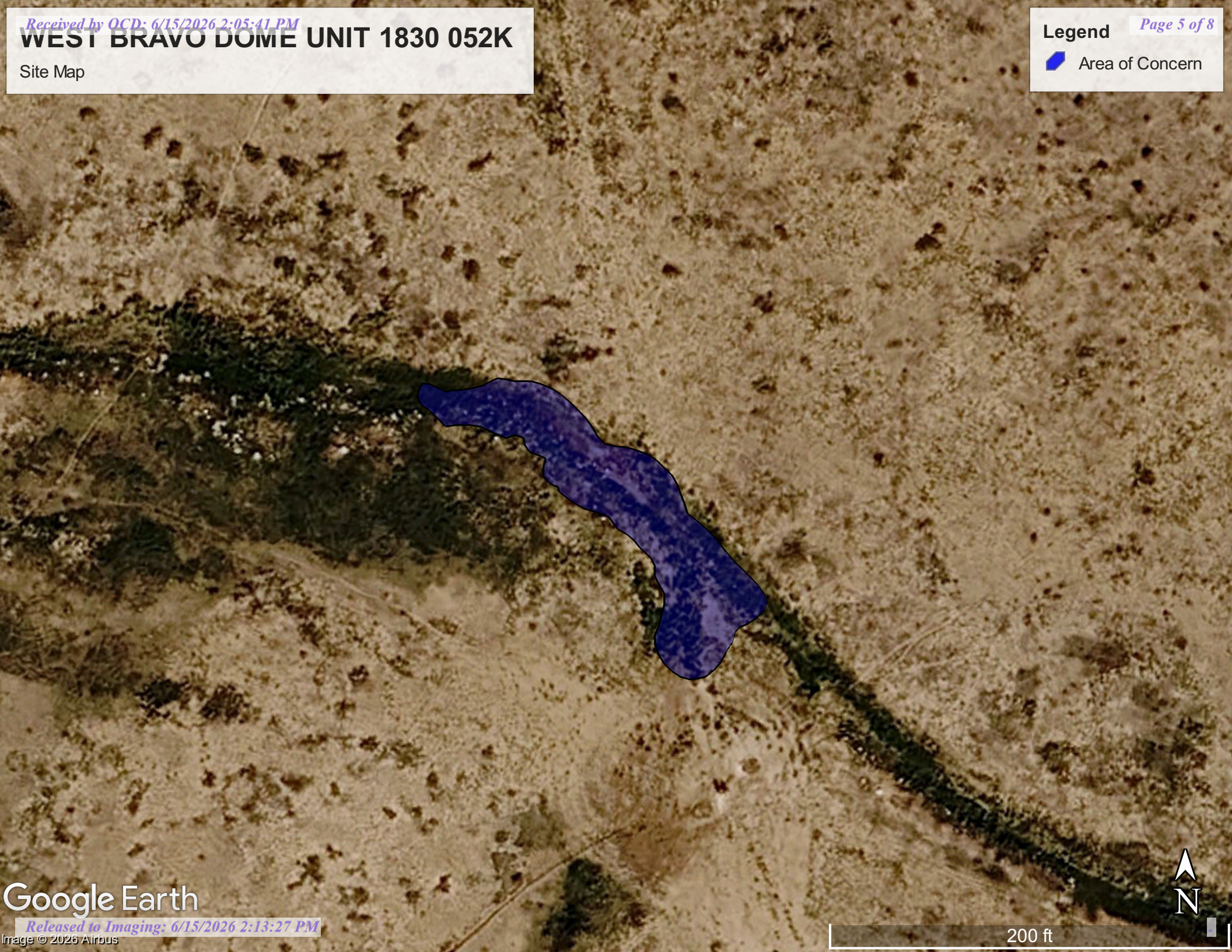


# WEST BRAVO DOME UNIT 1830 052K
