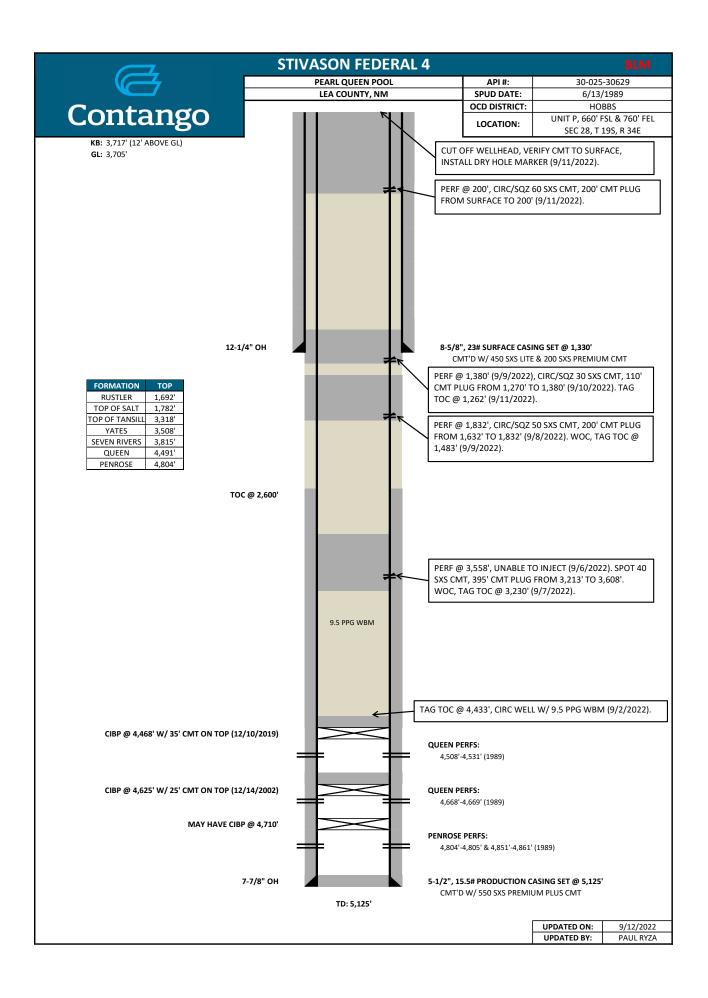

- 1. MIRU rig (8/31/2022). ND wellhead, NU BOP. Pull 5 jts tbg (9/1/2022).
- 2. Tag PBTD @ 4,433', circulated w/ 9.5 ppg mud, pressure tested csg to 1,000 psi, POOH w/ tbg (9/2/2022).
- 3. Operations suspended, rig crew on days-off (9/3/2022 9/5/2022).
- 4. Perforated @ 3,558', unable to inject into perfs, pressured up to 1,200 psi (9/6/2022).
