

JOB PROCEDURES

- 1. MIRU workover rig and associated equipment; NU and test BOP.
- 2. TOOH with tubing.
- 3. Pull 7" production casing from ~1983' to surface.
- 4. Run 7" production casing from surface and tie into existing 7" production casing at \sim 1983'.
- 5. Set a plug within 50' of the top of Paradox perforations (top perf 8535').
- 6. Load hole with fluid and perform MIT on casing with NMOCD witness (notify NMOCD 24+ hours before test) and submit results to regulatory group.
- 7. TIH and remove plug.
- 8. TIH and land production tbg. Return well to production.



Conditions of Approval

I. GENERAL

- A. All previous conditions of approval remain. Prior approval by the BLM-Authorized Office (Drilling and Production Section) is required for variance from the approved workover program. Emergency approval may be obtained orally, but such approval is contingent upon filing of a notice of intent within three business days. Any changes to the approved plan or any questions regarding drilling operations should be directed to BLM during regular business hours via Sundry Notice. Emergency program changes after hours should be directed to Joe Killins at 970-759-8988.
- **B.** Notify this office at least 48 hours in advance prior to start of operations.
- **C.** From the time operations are initiated and until operations are completed, a member of the drilling crew or the tool pusher shall maintain rig surveillance at all time, unless the well is secured with blowout preventers or cement plugs.
- **D.** Approval expires June 15, 2023.
