

- 6. Unseated pump and POOH with remaining rod configuration and same.
- 7. Released TAC, RIH to tag for fill, and scanned tubing OOH.
- 8. RIH with redressed TAC and tubing. Set TAC @ 3620'.
- 9. RIH with pump and rod string configuration.
- 10. Seated pump.
- 11. Loaded and tested tubing held.
- 12. RDMO on 10/29/2024.
- 13. Notified BLM/ NMOCD.
- 14. RWTP.
