Dear Ms. Russell:

We are in receipt of your letter of February 9, 2010 together with the commercial determination data for 6 Rosa Unit wells recently completed in the Dakota formation.

The Bureau of Land Management, by their letter of March 3, 2010 concurred with your determination that the Rosa Unit Well Nos. 146B, 188C and 14C are capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Dakota formation. The Rosa Unit Well Nos. 186, 184C and 22B are non-commercial and should be produced on a lease basis.

Please be advised that the Commissioner of Public Lands concurs with the Bureau of Land Management's determinations that the Rosa Unit Well Nos. 146B, 188C and 14C are commercial wells and are entitled to participate in the Dakota Participating Area. The Rosa Unit Well Nos. 186, 184C and 22B are non-commercial and should be produced on a lease basis.


The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) approved these amended schedules by their letter of March 19, 2010.
