Gentlemen:

We have determined that under existing conditions the Big Eddy Unit (BEU) No. 265H well is **not** capable of producing unitized substances from the Wolfcamp Formation in unit paying quantities. The well was completed in the Wolfcamp Formation on September 12, 2013. Since the well was determined to be a nonpaying unit well, a drilling and spacing unit must be established for the well so that a communitization agreement can be approved by the New Mexico State Office.
