

Dear Mr. Smith:

Reference is made to your request received in the Santa Fe office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division April 30, 2003, to increase the surface injection pressure on the above-referenced water disposal well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on this well on April 18, 2003. The test results have been reviewed and we feel an increase in injection pressure is justified at this time.

Without modifying the injection interval (4734-5590) or the tubing size or type (2-7/8 inch plastic coated), you are authorized to inject at or below **2,800 psi surface injection pressure**.

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
