Administrative application (Division administrative application reference No. pMES0-Re: 417546110) on behalf of SG Interests, I, Ltd. ("SGI") for an exception to the well location requirements [Rule 7 (a) (1)] provided within the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, for SGI's proposed Federal "29-9-27" Well No. 3 to be drilled at an unorthodox infill coal gas well location 365 feet from the North line and 1935 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool (71629), San Juan County, New Mexico.

Dear Mr. Garner:

You state in your application that the proposed SGI well is "encroaching on the S/2 of Section 22, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico," and that "[t]he off operators are listed" and "will be notified." However, your list does not include BP America Production Company ("BP"), who operates the Florance Well No. 119 (API No. 30-045-23976), a producing Basin Fruitland coal gas well in Lot 1 (Unit A) of Section 22 that is dedicated to 311.97 acres comprising the E/2 equivalent of Section 22.

Please submit proof of notice to BP so that I may continue processing your client's request in a timely fashion. Thank you.

Gentlemen:

SG Interests I, Ltd is proposing to drill a Fruitland Coal gas well in the NE/4 NW/4 of Sec 27, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. We staked a location within the window established by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission; however, BLM has advised us that the location we staked fell within "the 100 year floodplain of designated ephemeral wash riparian area" of Canyon Largo. BLM also recommended a more suitable location (365' FNL, 1935' FWL of Sec 27, T29N, R9W) even though it is a nonstandard location (See copy of Form C-102 Survey Plat and BLM letter dated June 4, 2004).
