Dear Ms. Wrotenbery:

Pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 104 F adopted on August 12, 1999, Manzano Oil Corporation hereby seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its S. V. Sundown State Well No. 1 at a point 477 feet from the South line and 191 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This unorthodox well location was approved in the Devonian formation by Division Order No. R-10263 entered in Case 11127 on November 29, 1994. The well has now been abandoned in the Devonian and completed in the Wolfcamp formation. There is also potential for a subsequent completion attempt in the San Andres formation. A standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 14 will be dedicated to the well in the Wolfcamp and San Andres formations.

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
This proposed unorthodox well location is unorthodox because it encroaches on offsetting tracts to the South, West and Southwest.

Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a plat showing the subject area and the proposed unorthodox well location. The acreage shaded yellow on Exhibit A is operated by Manzano Oil Corporation. The correlative rights of no interest owner will be adversely impacted by a well at this proposed unorthodox location for all acreage upon which the well encroaches is either operated by Manzano or owned by the State of New Mexico and is not currently under lease. Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a waiver to the proposed unorthodox well locations from the Commissioner of Public Lands. Accordingly, there are no affected persons as defined in Rule 1207.A to whom notice of this application should be provided.



Dear Jeff:

On November 29, 1994 the Oil Conservation Division approved Manzano Oil Corporation's unorthodox well location for the above referenced well (Order No. R-10263). The well was drilled and produced from the Devonian formation until recently when the well became uneconomical. On May 3, 2000 we plugged the Devonian formation and came up to and perforated the Wolfcamp formation. The Wolfcamp formation is currently flowing 185 BOPD. Manzano was given a temporary allowable until we receive administrative approval to produce the Wolfcamp formation at the unorthodox location. The State of New Mexico is the offset operator with unleased acreage located in Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23 of Township 10 South, Range 37 East.

Manzano Oil Corporation requests that the State of New Mexico waive any objection to the unorthodox location for the "SV" Sundown State #1 well producing from the Wolfcamp formation.
