Dear Mr. Harris:

As per your request on behalf of Ray Westall Operating, Inc. received in this office February 17, 2005, an extension of the deadline in which to convert to injection the State "NO" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-28468), approved by Division Order No. SWD-864, is hereby denied.

Division Order No SWD-864 was approved December 18, 2002, and was in effect, without the onset of injection, for one year. It has been over two years since this permit was approved and the permit expired over one year ago. In addition, this well may be in violation of Division Rule 201.

If you still need saltwater injection in this area, please work with our geologist in the ~~Alameda~~ District office to pick a well and formation as a suitable disposal, and apply to the Division for an injection permit.
