

Please find enclosed, in triplicate, a plat showing Unit "B" as requested. The discussion on the wording "impact to previously drilled new wells or proposed wells" should refer to the enclosed plat. Unfortunately, the plat submitted on July 29, 1999 with our application did not adequately convey the current status of development in this area.


As you will notice in Unit "B", the Dale H. Parke "A" Tr 1 No. 17 is an established producer. If the Dale H. Parke Tr 1 No. 22 were placed at an orthodox location, it would then require a move further south to allow enough room to safely construct a location due to the presence of the water pipeline. We believe an orthodox location, once moved away from the pipeline, would be too close to our existing well (No. 17) producing from the same horizon. This is the point I intended to make with the phrase "impact to previously drilled new wells or proposed wells". I realize now that this was a poor choice of words. Coupled with the outdated plat, I can understand your concern.









Plat showing the well spots in the N/2 of section 22 and the S/2 of section 15 in T17s-R30e
