
Dear Mr. Ezeanyim:

Seely Oil Company is requesting an extension to Administrative Order WFX-900 granting authorization to inject water into the Federal T No. 19 well on May 30, 2012. Over the past year, Seely has been actively working with the BLM seeking their approval to recomplete this well back into the Queen formation. We have just received verbal approval from the BLM provided that we can assure them we can have water injection started by May 30, 2013, or receive an extension from the Oil Conservation Division. We need to do some remedial work on the casing in order for the well to pass a mechanical integrity test which will prevent us from meeting the deadline of the end of the month.

An extension for another 6 to 12 months would be sufficient to get the well recompleted and equipped for water injection. The conditions in the order are the same and there have been no new wells drilled or plugged in the area of review.
