Reference is made to your application received on September 12, 2013.

You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by statewide Order No. R-12984, which provides for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary, and Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are less than 660 feet from an outer boundary of the project area.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].
