Reference is made to your application received on October 24, 2013.

You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the Special Rules for the Counselors Gallup-Dakota Pool, which provide for 160-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary, and Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are less than 660 feet from an outer boundary of the project area.

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Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location for engineering reasons.
