The commingled oil production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Black Jack State Com #1 tank battery Unit I, Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The proposed lease commingling (CTB) is in the best interests of conservation and prevention of waste from the affected wells. Correlative rights will not be impaired, and will not result in reduced royalty or improper measurement of production

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
