Reference is made to your application received on November 12, 2013.

You have requested to drill this well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by statewide Rule 15.9.A [19.15.15.9.A NMAC], which provides for 40-acre units with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 330 feet from a unit outer boundary, based on preliminary directional survey. Refer to letter from ConocoPhillips geologist on January 6, 2014 that states that the perforated interval occurs only within Unit G, Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM.

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Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location to recover additional oil and gas reserves.
