EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Hawk 35 Fed 8H Well** to be completed within the Red Hills; Upper Bone Spring Shale Pool (Pool Code 97900) underlying Section 26, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 500 feet from the North line and 1977 feet from the East line of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 33 East but completed wholly within Section 26. The upper most perforation will be 50 feet from the South line and 1386 feet from the East line of Section 26 (Unit O) and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1379 feet from the East line of Section 26 (Unit B). Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit this well will be unorthodox because the entire completed interval is closer than 330 feet to the eastern outer boundary. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will prevent waste of a productive reservoir and improve well performance.

Exhibit A is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Hawk 35 Fed 8H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the South, Southeast, East, and Northeast.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Section 26 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Hawk 35 Fed 8H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.



Devon Energy Corporation is the only affected parties to the Northeast and has been provided notice of this application by certified mail. EOG is the sole operator and mineral lessee of the federal lease covering Sections 26 and 35 and, therefore, there are no additional affected parties. A copy of this application has been provided to the Bureau of Land Management.




