Yates Petroleum Corporation requests an amendment to Division Order No. 473-A to add certain wells to the order. This request is approved, and YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION (OGRID 25575) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from North Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (**97565**) from the following leases and wells:

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Boyd X State Well No. 10 central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit O, Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated semi-annually in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.

This order supersedes Order No. CTB 473-A, issued April 15, 2013.

This approval is subject to like approval from the New Mexico State Land Office before commencing the commingling operations.
