The combined project area for these wells include the E/2 of Section 16 and E/2 E/2 of Sections 28, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Boone State Com. Well No. 2H Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit O, Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The oil and gas production from the Boone State Com. Well No. 1H, and Boone State Com. Well No. 2H which have identical ownership shall be metered with a combination of metering and testing. The Warbler State Com. Well No. 4H, which has diverse ownership shall be metered separately. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
