The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received Plains Pipeline, LP's (Plains) report and site closure request for the above-referenced site (dated November, 2010; received April 21, 2011). The report indicates that additional information is required:

Plains must continue to monitor groundwater for BTEX, chloride and TDS in MW-1 at least twice per year and submit a report to the OCD at least once per year.

Plains must submit re-vegetation documentation to the OCD within one year.
