Attached is a Form C-102 showing the project area and the producing area of this well.

The Vast State horizontal wells were spaced within this area of development to provide for efficient and maximum recovery of production from the Wolfcamp horizon. As can be seen on the enclosed lease map, this plan of development placed the Vast State #23H wellbore and LTP at an unorthodox location. COG drilling group drilled the lateral portion of this wellbore at a non-standard footage from the east quarter-section line of Section 17-T26S-R33E, therefore, we are seeking approval to also stimulate and produce the well from this non-standard footage.

COG Operating LLC ("COG") is applying to the NMOCD for the unorthodox well location listed above. COG is respectfully requesting that Occidental Permian Limited Partnership ("OXY") waive its right to protest the Subject Well which might impact OXY's lease in SW4SE4 of Section 8, T26S-R33E of which the Subject Well's LTP is approximately 355' diagonal to OXY's lease. The OCD requires that the diagonal takepoint of a wellbore be no closer than 467' from adjacent diagonal leases boundary lines. In exchange for OXY walving any objection and agreeing to COG's unorthodox well location, COG shall grant OXY one of the following options:

Dear Ms. Riley:

COG Operating LLC ("COG") respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") reconsider its denial of COG's application for a Non-Standard Well Location ("NSL") for the Vast State Well No. 23H ("Vast State") because the well is not subject to a ten-foot setback requirement, the affected tract operator waived objection to the unorthodox well location, and the ownership is common in the affected tracts.

I. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The Vast State (API #30-025-43552) is an oil well located in the E/2 E/2 of Section 17, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, and produces from the Wolfcamp formation, Sanders Tank; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98097). Vast State Plat and Well Diagram (attached as Exhibit A). In order to minimize surface interference, prevent waste throughout the drilling process, and maximize recovery of production, COG pad-drilled a number of wells, including the Vast State. This put Vast State's wellbore and Last Take Point ("LTP") at a nonstandard footage from the east quarter-section line of Section 17-T26S-R33E. As such, the producing interval of this well does not meet the 330-foot from the outer boundary of the producing area requirement indicated in 19.15.15.9 NMAC. This unorthodox position also put a portion of the Vast State within ten-feet from the quarter-quarter line.

COG and Occidental Permian LP ("OXY") are the only affected parties. COG is the operator and sole working interest owner in the W/2E/2 Section 17, as well as the acreage in the entire E/2 of Section 17. OXY is the federal lessee/operator in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 8-T26S-R23E. OXY has waived any objection to COG's non-standard wellbore. Request for Waiver of Objection -Application for Unorthodox Well Location (dated April 23, 2018) (attached as Exhibit B). Additionally, ownership is common in the E/2 of Section 17. Letter from Luke Bedrick to Leonard Lowe (dated Dec. 5, 2017) (attached as exhibit C).

Due to not meeting the 330-foot offset requirement found in 19.15.15.9 NMAC, COG filed for administrative approval of its application for a Non-Standard Well Location of Vast State on May, 7 2018 (attached as Exhibit D). However, the application was denied by the OCD on May 22, 2018 due to the well being within ten feet from the quarter-quarter line. *See* email from Leonard Lowe to Debora Wilbourn (dated May 22, 2018) (attached as Exhibit E).

II. NMAC PROVISIONS AS APPLIED TO VAST STATE

A. Vast State is not bound to a ten-foot setback requirement because it is governed by 19.15.15.9 NMAC.

19.15.15.9 NMAC governs oil wells located in primary recovery projects. It requires development wells for a defined oil pool to be "located on a spacing unit consisting of approximately 40 contiguous surface acres" 19.15.15.9(A) NMAC. The provision further articulates that the well "shall be located no closer than 330 feet to a boundary of the unit." *Id.* However, unlike 19.15.15.10 NMAC and 19.15.15.13 NMAC, a ten-foot setback requirement has not been written into 19.15.15.9 NMAC.

Here, 19.15.15.9 NMAC governs the Vast State because it is an oil well located in a primary recovery project. The Vast State is a development well for the Upper Wolfcamp pool – an OCD designated oil pool. Ex. A at 1. The well is located in the E/2 E/2 of Section 17, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County – which is approximately a 40 acre tract. *Id.* Due to the method by which the project was carried out, Vast State's producing interval was placed inside of the 330-foot boundary of the unit. Ex. D. Although, this also placed a portion of the Vast State within ten feet from the quarter-quarter line, there is no ten-foot setback requirement in 19.15.15.9 NMAC to apply against the well.

B. The ten-foot setback requirements in 19.15.15.10 and 19.15.15.13 NMAC do not apply to Vast State because it is an oil well located in a primary recovery project.

19.15.15.10 NMAC requires gas wells to have a ten-foot setback from any quarter-quarter (interior) boundary. Specifically, the requirement is set forth in Subsection A of 19.15.15.10 NMAC: "each development well for a *defined gas pool*. . . shall be located no closer than . . . 10 feet to a quarter-quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary." 19.15.15.10(A) NMAC (Emphasis added). However, this provision's ten-foot setback requirement does not apply to Vast State because it is an oil well.

Similarly, 19.15.15.13 NMAC requires unorthodox wells located in secondary or tertiary recovery projects or pressure maintenance projects to have a ten-foot setback. Subsection A of 19.15.15.13 NMAC states that: "[w]ell locations within a secondary recovery, tertiary recovery or pressure maintenance project . . . that are unorthodox based on 19.15.15.9 NMAC's requirements . . . are authorized, provided that the unorthodox location within the project is . . . no closer than 10

feet to a quarter-quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary." 19.15.15.13(A) NMAC (Emphasis added). This provision does not apply to Vast State because it is located within a primary recovery project.

III. <u>AFFECTED TRACT OPERATOR WAIVED OBJECTION TO NSL APPLICATION</u> AND THE AFFECTED TRACT'S HAVE COMMON OWNERSHIP INTERESTS

Occidental Permian LP ("OXY") is the federal lessee/operator of the offset tract – tract 2. Ex. D. OXY has provided COG with a letter waiving any objection to OCD approving Vast State's NSL application. Ex. B at 2. Additionally, all other ownership interests between the affected tracts are identical. Ex. C. Therefore, Vast State's unorthodox location of its producing interval will not affect the correlative rights of any of the royalty owners within the affected tracts.

IV. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

It appears that the basis for the denial of COG's NSL application is incorrect because the well does not violate any applicable ten-foot setback requirement. Additionally, ownership is common in the E/2 of Section 17, and the only other offsetting operator has waived objection to the application. Therefore, no correlative rights are being harmed. In light of these factors, COG is respectfully requesting that OCD reconsider its denial of COG's application and approve Vast State's NSL status.





A review of our title records indicates that 100 percent of the ownership of the oil and gas interests in the E/2 of Section 17 (both in ownership and quantum owned) are identical.

The Vast State horizontal wells were spaced within this area of development to provide for efficient and maximum recovery of production from the Wolfcamp horizon. As can be seen on the enclosed lease map, this plan of development placed the Vast State #23H wellbore and LTP at an unorthodox location. COG drilling group drilled the lateral portion of this wellbore at a non-standard footage from the east quarter-section line of Section 17-T26S-R33E, therefore, we are seeking approval to also stimulate and produce the well from this non-standard footage.

Tract 1 affected offset area for the non-standard wellbore is the W/2E/2 Section 17. COG is operator and sole working interest owner in the offset acreage, as well as the acreage in the entire E/2 of Section 17. A letter to that effect from the COG landman is included with this application. Tract 2 affected offset area is the SW/4SE/4 of Section 8-T26S-R23E. Occidental Permian LP (OXY) is the federal lessee/operator of this tract. OXY has provided COG with a letter waiving any objection to this planned non-standard wellbore.
