Reference is made to your application received on May 16, 2018.

You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. Subsection A of 19.15.15.9 NMAC governs this pool and provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary.

This well's completed interval is as close as 104 feet to the eastern edge. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 10, encroachment to the SW4 SW4

Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC, in all

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adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches. However, public notice is not required due to all affected parties submitted signed waivers.

The Division understands you seek this location to efficiently develop the project area underlying the project area located within the Gallup formation underlying the N2 SW4, SE4 SW4, S2 SE4 of Section 9.

Your application has been filed under 19.15.15.13 NMAC and Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC.

Per Subsection B of 19.15.15.13 NMAC, Division approves this unorthodox location.
