Reference is made to your application received on March 25, 2019.

This vertical well was drilled at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by Hearing Order R-11067, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells to be located at least 330 from the QTR/QTR line and 660 feet from outer unit boundaries.

This well's completed interval is as close as 220 feet to the western edge of the spacing unit. Encroachments will impact the following tract.

Section 14, encroachment to the NW4 SE4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (8) Subsection A of 19.15.2.7 NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches. However, the ownership is identical in the affected tract; therefore, notice is not required.

The Division understands that you seeking this well location to reduce surface disturbance as noted by the BLM's guidance and it was determined to be located at an unorthodox location underlying the spacing unit within the NE4 SE4 of Section 14.

Your application has been filed under Subsection 6 of Paragraph of Section (C) of 19.15.16.15 NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
