Reference is made to your application received on March 15, 2019.

You have requested to drill this directional well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by Division Rule 19.15.15.10.B (1) NMAC, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells to be located at least 330 feet from outer boundary of the quarter section on which the well is located.

This well's completed interval is as close as 200 feet to the southern edge and 179 feet to the northern edge of the spacing unit. Encroachments will impact the following tract.

Section 22, encroachment to the SW4 SW4 and NW4 SW4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (8) Subsection A of 19.15.2.7 NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches. However, the applicant is the operator within the encroaching area notice is not required.

The Division understands you request this unorthodox approval due recompleting this well in the Cherry Canyon formation requiring different set backs underlying the spacing unit within the SW4 SW4 of Section 11.

Your application has been filed under Subsection 6 of Paragraph of Section (C) of 19.15.16.15 NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC.

Per Subsection B of 19.15.15.13 NMAC, Division approves this unorthodox location.
