Within 2 of the 3 applications is included a statement that 100% of the oil would be allocated to a single pool which was sufficient. However, the 3rd application is lacking the fixed percent and I had mistakenly approved it. Please calculate and email me a fixed percent for the oil production for DHC-5174 which governs the commingling for San Juan 29 5 Unit #70 (30-039-21050).
