Reference is made to your application received on October 3rd, 2022.

This vertical well will be recompleted within an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by special pool rule, R-2421-A, which provides for 80-acre units, with wells to be located at least 200 feet from the center of the quarter sections.

This well's completed interval is as close as 395 feet to the southern boundary. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 32, encroachment to the E/2 SE/4

The Division understands you have given notice per R-2421, Rule 3 of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (8) Subsection A of 19.15.2.7 NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

Division understands that you are seeking this orthodox location due to economics of drilling and recompleting into a new formation within the Abo formation underlying the E/2 NE/4 of Section 32.

Your application has been filed under Subsection 6 of Paragraph of Section (C) of 19.15.16.15 NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC.

Per Subsection B of 19.15.15.13 NMAC, **Division approves this unorthodox location.**

Reference this NSL order number on the As Drilled C-102 submitted with the Authorization to Transport, to place this well into production.

The above approvals are subject to your following all other applicable Division rules.

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of further orders as Division deems necessary.
