On January 27, 2006, El Paso Tennessee Pipeline Company (EPTPC), formerly El Paso Field Services (EPFS), submitted a document to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) entitled San Juan River Basin Program – Jaquez Site: Final 2005 Annual and Closure Report. This report presented the project history, including remedial activities conducted by EPFS/EPTPC between 1993 and 2005 to successfully address soil and groundwater impacts at the site. The report also presented the 2005 site groundwater monitoring data, which indicated that concentrations of the constituents of concern in the groundwater were below their respective New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Ground Water Standards for four consecutive quarters. These results met the closure criteria set forth in the OCD-approved remediation plan for groundwater encountered during pit closure activities (EPFS, November 29, 1995). Accordingly, EPTPC recommended site closure in its January 27, 2006 report submittal.

EPTPC respectfully requests that this case be closed by the OCD. Following approval of site closure, EPTPC will properly plug and abandon the network of groundwater monitoring / remediation wells and conduct other site restoration activities.
