I. The well is on New Mexico State Land Office (NMSLO) oil and gas lease X0-0647-0405 and State surface. The well bore is 1,525' from the closest lease line. The proposed oil well is nonstandard for the Artesia; Glorieta-Yeso (O) Pool (96830) due to land uses. A copy of the APD cover sheet is attached (Exhibit A).

Apache requests a nonstandard location due to land uses. There are already two overhead power lines, 3 pipelines rights-of-way (2 El Paso & 1 Western Gas), 3 Yeso wells, 2 Queen-Grayburg-San Andres wells, 2 plugged and abandoned wells, one authorized but as yet un-built caliche pit, well roads, and multiple lease pipelines in the NWSW Section 25.

The 8,746.59 acre state lease comprises all of Sections 25 and 26, NE4 Section 35, N2 Section 36, et al. The well was planned to be staked at 1650 FNL & 1650 FWL. However, that would force two overhead 3 phase power lines and two buried pipelines to be rerouted (see Exhibit B).

A standard location must be at least 330' from the quarter-quarter line. The well bore is 205' from the closest quarter-quarter line (see C-102 as EXHIBIT C). It is 125' too far north.

II. A C-102 form showing the well and 40 acre pro ration unit (SENW Section 25) is attached as EXHIBIT C.

The oil and gas lease boundary is marked as a solid line on the attached (EXHIBIT D) topographic map. The well bore encroaches too far (125') north. All encroachments are part of the same state lease. There are 3 Yeso wells in the encroached quarter-quarter (NENW Section 25). All three are Apache wells. The quarter-quarter is part of the same state lease. All eight bordering or cornering quarter-quarters (dashed line squares) are part of the same state lease. Next closest quarter-quarter (SWNW Section 25) is 350' west.

III. See Exhibit F for existing Yeso wells (circles). Apache operates all Yeso wells (circles on Exhibit E) in the 8 offset quarter-quarters. Closest (699') approved Yeso well is Apache's NB Tween State 25 (30-015-39075) at 990 FNL & 2310 FWL 25-17s-28e. It has not yet been drilled. Closest (819') existing Yeso well is Apache's NB Tween State 9 (30-015-36797) at 1650 FNL & 2480 FWL 25-17s-28e. Apache has Yeso wells in all 8 of the offset offset quarter-quarter-quarters. This information is current and correct.

IV. See Exhibits C and E for the proposed well, proration unit, drilling windows, and all wells. Apache does not believe it is cost effective to directionally drill from an existing pad.

V. See Exhibits B and E for surface uses (two overhead power lines, 3 pipelines rights-of-way (2 El Paso & 1 Western Gas), 3 Yeso wells, 2 Queen-Grayburg-San Andres wells, 2 plugged and abandoned wells, one authorized but as yet un-built caliche pit, well roads, and multiple lease pipelines) that prevent use of a legal location.

VI. Archaeology is not an issue.

VII. The well was planned to be staked at 1650 FNL & 1650 FWL. However, that would force the reroute of tow overhead 3 phase power lines and two buried non=Apache pipelines (see Exhibit B).

VIII. Apache does not believe directional drilling to a legal bottom hole location is cost effective.

IX. I hereby certify that Apache Corporation and its partners have 100% of the Yeso working interest in the lease which comprises the proposed 40 acre spacing unit and the adjacent quarter-quarters on one or more of the two sides or the single closest corner to the proposed well toward which it encroaches and that the information is current and correct.

I hereby attest that I, on or before the date that the application was submitted to the division, sent notification to the affected persons (see EXHIBIT F) by certified mail, return receipt requested, advising them that if they have an objection it must be filed in writing within 20 days from the
