Reference is made to your application received on March 24, 2012.

You have requested to complete this directional well at an unorthodox gas well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the Special Rules for the Basin-Mancos Gas Pool which provide for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary, and Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are less than 660 feet from an outer boundary of the project area.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location in order to utilize an existing wellbore completed in other formations.
