The line release was repaired on 10/10/11. Soil and groundwater investigation activities were conducted on 10/10/11. Contaminated soils and groundwater were removed from the excavation for line repair access. Soil and grab groundwater samples were collected for laboratory analysis. Upon receipt of laboratory reports, a site investigation workplan will be submitted for approval. A copy of the investigation report will be submitted to applicable agencies.

Once the area has been delineated, an appropriate OCD approved remediation method will be implemented at this location.
