An approximate size of 8' x 40' was impacted. The impacted area is located South of the well on the edge of the well pad. Soil from the pooling areas was excavated and placed in plastic and will be disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will taken and analysis ran for TPH and BTEX once all contaminated material has been removed. Depth to Ground Water: >50' (approx. 95', per New Mexico State Engineers Office); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 10.
