Please find the enclosed data and plats on the sampling performed at the Alamo -Empire J Federal #3 located in Eddy County, NM. Referring to Table 1, majority of the impacted areas were not vertically defined and deeper samples could not be collected due to the dense formation. Southern NM Archaeological Service, Inc (SNMA) has completed the survey and found not arch sites in vicinity of the spill area. The arch survey report has been forward to the BLM for review.
