ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on June 10, 1975, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 17th day of June, 1975, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Mobil Oil Corporation, seeks approval for the unorthodox location of its Brainard Gas Com Well No. 2, to be located 1180 feet from the North line and 1505 feet from the East line of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant further seeks approval for the E/2 of said Section 11 to be simultaneously dedicated to said well and to applicant's Brainard Gas Com Well No. 1, located in Unit P of said Section 11.

(4) That approval of the application will better enable the applicant to produce the gas under Section 11 and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Mobil Oil Corporation, is hereby given approval for the unorthodox location of its Brainard Gas Com Well No. 2, to be located 1180 feet from the North line and 1505 feet from the East line of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Eddy County,

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New Mexico, the E/2 of said Section 11 to be simultaneously dedicated to said well and to applicant's Brainard Gas Com Well No. 1, located in Unit P of said Section 11.


(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
