REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the NDDUP Tank Battery facility located at NDDUP Well No. 127 within the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 30, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementating commingling operations.

PROVIDING: The applicant shall obtain like approval to surface commingle from the Commissioner of Public Lands and the U.S. Bureau of Land Management.
