Dear Mr. Stone:

Per your letter dated January 29, 1996, regarding an allocation method on DHC-1175 - Mesa Verde "7" Federal #2, we are submitting a proposed fixed percentage allocation based on a stabilized production rate after sixty days.

The well is currently producing ± 30 BOPD, 55 MCF/d, and 58 BWPD. Of this production it is projected that the Bone Spring is contributing 9 BOPD, 11 MCF, and 8 BWPD. This represents 30% of the oil, 20% of the gas, and 15% of the water. It is thereby requested to keep these percentages for allocation purposes for the commingled production in the well.
