The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the CAP Report for the Walter Lynch Tank Battery Release Site, dated December 3, 2012, and has conducted a review of the report. The report indicates that Apache Corporation, Inc. (Apache) has substantially met the requirements of 19.15.29 NMAC (Rule 29; formerly, Rule 116) for a remediation plan. Therefore, the OCD hereby conditionally approves the report for above-referenced site in accordance with 19.15.29 NMAC:

Apache must submit to the OCD a report regarding continued corrective actions by Monday, December 9, 2013.
