Dear Ms. Staley:

Recent discussions with Mr. Ernie Busch of the Division's Aztec district office indicates that Amoco Production Company finished recompletion operations on its Riddle Com "A" Well No. 1M on February 8, 1996. As indicated on Form C-103, these recompletion operations were undertaken in order to downhole commingle the Basin-Dakota and Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pools within the wellbore.

Our records further indicate that on February 21, 1996, the Division received an application from Amoco to downhole commingle the subject well in the Mesaverde-Dakota interval. This application is still pending and is not due to be released until March 12, 1996.

Please be advised that Form C-103 (Sundry Notice) and Form C-104 (Authority to Produce) will not be signed by the Division until a downhole commingling order is issued for the well. In addition, please be advised that submittal of an application to downhole commingle a well does not automatically guarantee its approval. Denial of an application for any reason would necessarily require Amoco to perform operations on the well to separate the producing horizons.
