Chevron Midcontinent, L.P. ("Chevron") is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from South Culebra Bluff; Bone Spring, Pool (**15011**), and from the following State of New Mexico leases and wells:

Heritage 2 15 Well No. 2H (**API No. 30-015-40818**), Unit M, Sect. 15, T-23-S, R-28-E.
Heritage 2 15 Well No. 1H (**API No. 30-015-40166**), Unit N, Sect 15, T-23-S, R-28 E.

All in NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB), located at, in Unit N, Section 15 Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The commingled gas production will be measured and sold at the gas sales meter.

Commingling authority is granted for these wells upon the express condition that all oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from any other well. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the New Mexico State Land Office (SLO) before commencing the commingling operations.
