Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken

Technician discovered release location and later confirmed to be on Enterprise Pipeline. Leak is on 8" line branching off lateral A-18, 12" line, about 9 mi ft. of 12" line will be shut in, line will be LO/TO and blown down. Leak is located in T-23S, R-26E and Section 10 in Carlsbad N.M., Eddy County, no report of fire, no injuries and no fluid on ground due to leak.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.

A standard one-call will be initiated to expedite repairs. Producers were notified of shut in, there were several wells shut in due to leak, approximately 9 miles of pipeline will be blown down. Estimated gas loss 8.4 MMscf, anticipated gas loss due to pipeline leak and 1.4 MMscf due to pipeline blow down to perform safe repairs. Total 9.8 MMscf sweet natural gas.
